



PESIC Grant for a Physical Education Post-secondary Student to attend a Physical and Health Education Canada National Conference

Purpose

This Professional Development grant will allow for partial funding of an individual enrolled in a post secondary physical education program in NL to attend the a Physical and Health Education Canada National Conference.

Eligibility

All applicants must give documented evidence that additional sources of funding have been investigated and provide details of funding received.

To be eligible, an individual must be enrolled in a NL post-secondary institution with a major in physical education or related discipline (as deemed by the PESIC Executive).

The applicant must not have received any financial assistance from PESIC within the previous two school years.

Selection

The PESIC Executive will review all applications. The Executive shall give consideration to the following:

- Funding received from other sources, i.e. grants from their institution...
- Commitment of the applicant to share their professional development in NL, either through Professional Development within their institution or the next PESIC Conference.
- Letter of Support from a present or past professor in a course relating to physical education that acknowledges that you are a worthy candidate for a grant to attend the PHE Canada Conference.

Funding Guidelines

The following guidelines apply:

- **Travel, accommodation and registration will be covered**, up to 75 percent of the total cost of the conference and no more than \$250.00;
- Funds will only be awarded when proof of attendance and necessary receipts are received.
- **Reporting**

An individual who receives assistance to attend a PHE Canada National Conference will be awarded funds upon submission of receipts. Receipts and report are due within 30 days of completion of the conference. Failure to report by the deadline will constitute waiver of grant.

Deadlines

Deadline for applications will be 6 months prior to a conference) Grants shall be awarded for PHE Canada National Conferences assuming there are suitable applications and funds available. **Funds must be approved in advance.**

The program does not offer retroactivity.
